**animal** /ˈæniml/ (A1)

**животное**

a living thing that can move and is not a plant or a person

Lions are wild animals.

Львы — дикие животные.

**ant** /ænt/ (B1)

**муравей**

a very small insect that lives in large groups underground or in wood

A line of ants was carrying crumbs of bread back to their nest.

Вереница муравьёв несла крошки хлеба обратно в своё гнездо.

**ape** /eɪp/ (B1)

**человекообразная обезьяна**

a large primate (animal like a monkey but without a tail), such as a chimpanzee or gorilla

Apes are among the most intelligent animals on Earth.

Человекообразные обезьяны — одни из умнейших животных на Земле.

**beak** /bi:k/ (B2)

**клюв**

the hard pointed part of a bird's mouth

The bird used its beak to crack open the nut.

Птица использовала клюв, чтобы расколоть орех.

**bear** /beə/ (A1)

**медведь**

a large, heavy wild animal with thick fur

We saw a bear in the forest during our hike.

Во время похода мы увидели медведя в лесу.

**beast** /bi:st/ (B1)

**зверь**

A large, strong, or dangerous wild animal

The hunters tracked the beast through the dark forest for several days.

Охотники несколько дней преследовали зверя в тёмном лесу.

**beaver** /ˈbi:və/ (B1)

**бобёр**

A large animal with a wide flat tail that builds dams across rivers using trees it has cut down

Beavers build dams to create deep, still water where they can live safely.

Бобры строят плотины, чтобы создать глубокие тихие водоёмы для безопасного обитания.

**bee** /bi:/ **A1**

**пчела**

A flying insect with a yellow and black body that can sting and makes honey

The bees were buzzing around the flowers.

Пчёлы жужжали вокруг цветов.

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**bird** /bɜ:d/ **A1**

**птица**

an animal with feathers, wings, and a beak that usually can fly

A flock of birds flew over the lake.

Стая птиц пролетела над озером.

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**breed** /bri:d/ **B1**

**порода**

A type of animal that has been developed by people with particular characteristics

What breed of dog do you have?

Какой породы у тебя собака?

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**bull** /bʊl/ **B1**

**бык**

an adult male cow or other large male animal such as an elephant or whale

A bull escaped from the farm and ran down the road.

Бык сбежал с фермы и побежал по дороге.

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**butterfly** /'bʌtəflaɪ/ **A1**

**бабочка**

an insect with large, often brightly coloured wings that develops from a caterpillar

Butterflies are attracted to flowers with sweet nectar.

Бабочек привлекают цветы со сладким нектаром.

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**cage** /keɪdʒ/ **B1**

**клетка**

A structure made of bars or wires in which animals or birds are kept

The zoo tried to build larger, more natural spaces instead of small cages.

Зоопарк старался строить более просторные и естественные пространства вместо маленьких клеток.

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**calf** /kɑ:f/ **B1**

**телёнок**

A young cow or bull; also the young of some other large animals such as elephants or whales

The farmers were pleased to see the new calf standing on its shaky legs just hours after birth.

Фермеры были рады видеть нового телёнка, стоящего на нетвёрдых ногах спустя несколько часов после рождения.

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**camel** 'kæml (B1)

**верблюд**

a large animal with one or two humps on its back that lives in desert areas and is used for carrying people and goods

Tourists rode camels across the sand dunes of the Sahara Desert.

Туристы ехали на верблюдах по песчаным дюнам пустыни Сахара.

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**cat** /kæt/ (A1)

**кошка**

a small furry animal often kept as a pet, known for purring and catching mice

My cat sleeps on the sofa all day.

Моя кошка спит на диване весь день.

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**cattle** /'kætl/ (B1)

**крупный рогатый скот**

large farm animals kept for their milk or meat

The farmer keeps 200 head of cattle.

Фермер держит 200 голов крупного рогатого скота.

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**chimpanzee** /ˌtʃɪmpæn'zi:/ (A2)

**шимпанзе**

a small African ape with dark fur that is very intelligent and is the closest living relative to humans

Chimpanzees use simple tools, such as sticks, to get food.

Шимпанзе используют простые орудия, например палки, для добывания пищи.

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**clam** klæm (B2)

**моллюск**

a type of shellfish with two shells that can be eaten, which lives in sand or mud

We had steamed clams with garlic butter for dinner.

На ужин у нас были паровые моллюски с чесночным маслом.

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**coral** /'kɒrəl/ (B2)

**коралл**

A hard, rock-like substance formed by tiny sea animals, often used in jewellery; or the colour pink-orange.

The diver admired the beautiful coral on the ocean floor.

Дайвер любовался красивыми кораллами на дне океана.

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**cow** /kaʊ/ (A1)

**корова**

a large female farm animal kept for its milk and meat

The farmer milked the cows every morning before breakfast.

Фермер доил коров каждое утро до завтрака.

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**crab** /kræb/ **B2**

**краб**

a sea creature with a hard shell, ten legs and two large claws

We went to the beach and caught crabs in the rock pools.

Мы пошли на пляж и поймали крабов в каменных ваннах.

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**creature** /'kri:tʃə/ **A2**

**существо**

any living thing, especially an animal

Strange creatures live in the depths of the ocean.

В глубинах океана живут странные существа.

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**crocodile** /'krɒk.ə.daɪl/ **B2**

**крокодил**

a large reptile with a long body, strong jaws, and thick scaly skin, living in tropical rivers

A crocodile was resting on the bank of the river.

Крокодил отдыхал на берегу реки.

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**crow** /krəʊ/ **B1**

**ворона**

A large black bird with a loud call, common in many parts of the world

A crow perched on the fence and watched us with its bright eyes.

Ворона уселась на забор и наблюдала за нами своими блестящими глазами.

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**deer** /diə/ **B2**

**олень**

a large wild animal with long legs that eats grass; males usually have large branching horns called antlers

We saw a deer standing at the edge of the forest.

Мы увидели оленя, стоящего на краю леса.

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**dinosaur** /'daɪ.nə.sɔː/ **A2**

**динозавр**

a very large reptile that lived millions of years ago and is now extinct

The museum had a huge dinosaur skeleton on display.

В музее был выставлен огромный скелет динозавра.

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**dog** /dɒg/ **A1**

**собака**

a common domestic animal often kept as a pet

She has a big dog called Max.

У неё есть большая собака по имени Макс.

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## **dolphin** /ˈdɒlfɪn/ **B1**

### **дельфин**

a small, intelligent sea mammal with a long snout, known for being friendly and playful

We watched a group of dolphins swimming alongside the boat.

Мы наблюдали, как стая дельфинов плыла рядом с лодкой.

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## **donkey** /ˈdɒŋki/ **B2**

### **осёл**

an animal like a small horse with long ears, used for carrying loads or riding

The children went for a donkey ride on the beach.

Дети покатались на осле на пляже.

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## **dove** /dɒv/ **B2**

### **голубь**

A white or grey bird similar to a pigeon, used as a symbol of peace

A white dove was released at the ceremony as a symbol of peace and hope.

На церемонии выпустили белого голубя как символ мира и надежды.

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## **dragon** /ˈdræɡən/ **A2**

### **дракон**

a large, imaginary animal that breathes fire and looks like a lizard with wings

The knight fought a dragon to save the princess.

Рыцарь сразился с драконом, чтобы спасти принцессу.

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## **duck** /dʌk/ **A2**

### **утка**

A common water bird with a flat beak, short legs, and webbed feet.

We threw bread to the ducks in the park pond.

Мы кидали хлеб уткам в пруду в парке.

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## **dwarf** /dwɔːf/ **B2**

### **карлик**

A person, animal, or plant that is much smaller than the normal size; in stories, a small person-like creature

The garden was decorated with little stone dwarfs holding lanterns.

Сад был украшен маленькими каменными гномами, держащими фонари.

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## **eagle** /ˈiːɡl/ **B2**

### **орёл**

a large, strong bird that catches and eats small animals

The eagle soared high above the mountain peaks.

Орёл парил высоко над горными вершинами.

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## elephant /ˈelɪfənt/ **A2**

### слон

A very large grey mammal with big ears, long nose (trunk), and tusks, native to Africa and Asia

African elephants are the largest land animals on Earth.

Африканские слоны — самые крупные наземные животные на Земле.

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## feather ˈfeðə **A2**

### перо

one of the light soft flat things that cover a bird's body

The bird's feathers were brightly coloured and beautiful.

Перья птицы были ярко окрашены и красивы.

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## fish /fɪʃ/ **A1**

### рыба

a creature that lives in water, breathes through gills, and has fins and a tail

We saw many colourful fish in the aquarium.

Мы увидели много ярких рыб в аквариуме.

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## flea fli: **A2**

### блоха

a very small insect without wings that jumps and lives on animals or humans, feeding on blood

The dog was scratching because it had fleas.

Собака чесалась, потому что у неё были блохи.

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## flock /flɒk/ **B1**

### стая

A group of birds or sheep; or a large group of people.

A flock of geese flew overhead in V-formation.

Стая гусей пролетела над нами клином.

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## fox /fɒks/ **B2**

### лиса

a wild animal with a long bushy tail and reddish-brown fur

A fox raided the chicken coop in the middle of the night.

Ночью лиса забралась в курятник.

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## frog frɒɡ **A1**

### лягушка

a small animal with smooth skin, long back legs for jumping, and lives near water

We heard frogs croaking in the pond at night.

Ночью мы слышали кваканье лягушек в пруду.

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**fur** /fɜː/ **B1**

**мех**

the soft thick hair that covers some animals; a piece of clothing made from this

The fox has beautiful red fur that keeps it warm in winter.

У лисы красивый рыжий мех, который согревает её зимой.

**giraffe** /dʒɪˈrɑːf/ **B1**

**жираф**

a very tall African animal with a very long neck and long legs, covered with dark patches

The giraffe stretched its long neck to reach the leaves at the top of the tree.

Жираф вытянул длинную шею, чтобы дотянуться до листьев на верхушке дерева.

**goat** /gəʊt/ **B2**

**коза**

A farm animal with horns and a short tail, related to the sheep, kept for its milk and meat

The farmer kept goats on the hillside for their milk.

Фермер держал коз на склоне холма ради молока.

**gorilla** ɡəˈrɪlə **B1**

**горилла**

The largest type of ape, which has black fur and lives in Africa

Gorillas are highly intelligent animals that live in family groups.

Гориллы — высокоинтеллектуальные животные, которые живут семейными группами.

**hatching** ˈhætʃɪŋ **B2**

**вылупление**

the process of a young animal breaking out of an egg

We watched the hatching of the baby turtles on the beach.

Мы наблюдали за вылуплением черепах на пляже.

**hay** heɪ **B2**

**сено**

dried grass that is used as food for farm animals

The farmer stacked the hay in the barn before the rain came.

Фермер сложил сено в амбар до начала дождя.

**herd** /hɜːd/ **B1**

**стадо**

a large group of animals of the same type that live and feed together

A herd of elephants crossed the river to reach the water hole.

Стадо слонов перешло реку, чтобы добраться до водопоя.

**horn** /hɔ:n/ **B1**

**рог**

A hard, pointed growth on the head of some animals, such as cows or deer.

The bull lowered its horns and charged.

Бык опустил рога и бросился вперёд.

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**horse** /hɔ:s/ **A1**

**лошадь**

a large animal with four legs, a mane, and a tail, used for riding and carrying loads

She learned to ride a horse when she was five years old.

Она научилась ездить верхом в пять лет.

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**hunter** 'hʌntə **A2**

**охотник**

a person or animal that hunts other animals for food or sport

The lion is one of the most skilled hunters on the African savannah.

Лев — один из самых искусных охотников африканской саванны.

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**insect** /'ɪnsekt/ **A2**

**насекомое**

A small creature with six legs and usually wings, such as a fly or ant.

Bees are important insects for pollinating plants.

Пчёлы — важные насекомые для опыления растений.

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**ivory** /'aɪ.vər.i/ **B1**

**слоновая кость**

the hard, creamy-white substance that the tusks (long teeth) of elephants are made of

The sale of ivory is banned in many countries to protect elephants.

Продажа слоновой кости запрещена во многих странах для защиты слонов.

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**kangaroo** /ˌkæŋ.gə'ru:/ **B2**

**кенгуру**

a large Australian marsupial with strong hind legs, used for jumping, and a pouch for carrying young

The kangaroo leaped across the dusty road as they drove through the outback.

Кенгуру перепрыгнул через пыльную дорогу, когда они ехали по бушу.

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**kitten** /'kɪt.ən/ **B1**

**котёнок**

a very young cat

The cat had five kittens last month.

В прошлом месяце у кошки родилось пять котят.

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**lamb** /læm/ (B1)

**ягнёнок**

a young sheep; the meat from a young sheep

Roast lamb is a traditional dish served at Easter.

Жареная баранина — традиционное блюдо, подаваемое на Пасху.

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**lark** lɑ:k (B2)

**жаворонок**

a small brown bird that sings while flying high in the sky; also (informal) something done for fun or as a joke

We climbed the mountain just for a lark, not really expecting the view to be so amazing.

Мы полезли на гору просто ради забавы, не ожидая, что вид окажется таким потрясающим.

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**leash** /li:f/ (B2)

**поводок**

a long piece of rope, leather, or chain used to control a dog or other animal

Please keep your dog on a leash when walking in the park.

Пожалуйста, держите собаку на поводке во время прогулки в парке.

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**leopard** 'lepəd (B2)

**леопард**

a large wild cat with yellow fur and black spots, found in Africa and Asia

The leopard leaped silently through the tall grass.

Леопард бесшумно прыгал сквозь высокую траву.

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**lion** /'laɪən/ (A1)

**лев**

a large wild cat with a mane, living in Africa

We saw lions resting under a tree during the safari.

Во время сафари мы видели львов, отдыхающих под деревом.

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**monkey** /'mʌŋ.ki/ (A1)

**обезьяна**

A small to medium-sized primate, typically with a long tail, that lives in tropical forests

The children laughed as the monkey swung from branch to branch.

Дети смеялись, когда обезьяна прыгала с ветки на ветку.

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**monster** /'mɒnstə/ (B1)

**монстр**

A large, frightening creature in stories; or a very cruel or evil person.

The children hid under the bed, afraid of the monster in the story.

Дети спрятались под кроватью, испугавшись монстра из истории.

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**mosquito** /mə'ski:təʊ/ **B1**

**комар**

a small flying insect that bites people and animals and sucks their blood, sometimes spreading disease

She covered herself in insect repellent to avoid mosquito bites.

Она намазалась репеллентом от насекомых, чтобы избежать укусов комаров.

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**mouse** /maʊs/ **A1**

**мышь**

a small furry animal with a long tail and sharp teeth

The cat caught a mouse in the garden.

Кот поймал мышь в саду.

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**mule** /mju:l/ **B1**

**мул**

an animal whose parents are a horse and a donkey, used especially for carrying loads

The mule carried heavy supplies up the mountain path.

Мул нёс тяжёлые припасы по горной тропе.

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**nest** nest **A2**

**гнездо**

a structure built by birds or insects to live in and lay eggs

The bird built a nest in the tree.

Птица свила гнездо на дереве.

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**owl** /aʊl/ **B2**

**сова**

A bird with large round eyes and a flat face that hunts at night

We heard an owl hooting in the darkness as we walked through the forest at night.

Идя ночью через лес, мы услышали уханье совы во тьме.

---

**parrot** 'pærət **B1**

**попугай**

a tropical bird with bright coloured feathers that can be taught to copy human speech

The parrot in the pet shop could say 'hello' and 'goodbye' in three languages.

Попугай в зоомагазине умел говорить «привет» и «пока» на трёх языках.

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**paw** pɔ: **B2**

**лапа**

the foot of an animal that has claws or nails, such as a cat or dog

The dog lifted its paw and placed it on my knee.

Собака подняла лапу и положила её мне на колено.

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**penguin** /ˈpɛŋɡwɪn/ **B2**

**пингвин**

A black and white seabird from the southern hemisphere that cannot fly but is an excellent swimmer

Emperor penguins survive the Antarctic winter by huddling together for warmth.

Императорские пингвины переживают антарктическую зиму, прижимаясь друг к другу для тепла.

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**pet** /pet/ **A1**

**домашнее животное**

an animal kept in the home as a companion

We have two pets: a cat and a rabbit.

У нас два питомца: кошка и кролик.

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**pig** /pɪɡ/ **A1**

**свинья**

A farm animal with a fat body, short legs, and a flat nose, kept for its meat.

The children fed the pigs on the farm.

Дети кормили свиней на ферме.

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**puppy** /ˈpʌpi/ **B1**

**щенок**

a young dog

They got a golden retriever puppy for Christmas.

На Рождество им подарили щенка золотистого ретривера.

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**python** ˈpaɪθən **A2**

**питон**

a large snake that kills animals by squeezing them

Pythons are found in Africa and Asia.

Питоны встречаются в Африке и Азии.

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**rabbit** /ˈræbɪt/ **A1**

**кролик**

a small animal with long ears and soft fur that lives in holes in the ground

The children loved feeding the rabbits in the park.

Дети обожали кормить кроликов в парке.

---

**rat** ræt **A1**

**крыса**

a small animal with a long tail, similar to but larger than a mouse

The old warehouse was full of rats that fed on the stored grain.

Старый склад был полон крыс, которые питались запасами зерна.

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**rhinoceros** /raɪ'nɒsərəs/ **B2**

**носорог**

a very large animal with thick grey skin and one or two horns on its nose, found in Africa and Asia

The wildlife photographer managed to capture a rhinoceros drinking from a river.

Фотограф дикой природы сумел снять носорога, пьющего из реки.

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**seal** /si:l/ **B2**

**тюлень**

a large sea animal with a smooth body that lives in cold areas and eats fish

We saw a seal sunbathing on the rocks near the shore.

Мы увидели тюленя, загорающего на камнях у берега.

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**sheep** /ʃi:p/ **A1**

**овца**

a farm animal with thick wool that is kept for its wool and meat

There are hundreds of sheep on this farm.

На этой ферме сотни овец.

---

**shell** /ʃel/ **A2**

**ракушка**

the hard outer covering of an egg, nut, or sea creature such as a snail or shellfish

The children collected shells on the beach.

Дети собирали ракушки на пляже.

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**slaughter** /'slɔ:tə/ **B2**

**резня**

The killing of many people or animals at one time in a cruel and unfair way

The slaughter of civilians during the war was condemned by international organisations.

Массовое убийство мирных жителей во время войны было осуждено международными организациями.

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**snake** /sneɪk/ **A1**

**змея**

A long thin reptile with no legs that moves by sliding its body along the ground

I saw a snake in the garden this morning.

Сегодня утром я увидел змею в саду.

---

**sparrow** 'spærəʊ **B2**

**воробей**

a small brown or grey bird that is very common

A little sparrow sat on the fence and sang.

Маленький воробей сидел на заборе и чирикал.

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**spider** /'spaɪ.dər/ **B1**

**паук**

A small creature with eight legs that catches insects in webs it makes from very thin threads

I found a large spider in the bathroom this morning and had to remove it carefully.

Сегодня утром я обнаружил большого паука в ванной и аккуратно убрал его.

---

**swan** swɒn **B2**

**лебедь**

a large white bird with a long neck that lives on rivers and lakes

A pair of swans glided gracefully across the lake.

Пара лебедей грациозно скользила по озеру.

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**swarm** /swɜːm/ **B1**

**рой**

a large group of insects, especially bees, moving together

A swarm of bees flew out of the hive.

Из улья вылетел рой пчёл.

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**tail** /teɪl/ **B2**

**хвост**

the rear part of an animal's body, often a flexible elongated extension of the spine

The dog wagged its tail excitedly when its owner came home.

Собака радостно завиляла хвостом, когда хозяин вернулся домой.

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**tiger** /'taɪ.gər/ **A1**

**тигр**

a large wild cat with orange and black stripes that lives in Asia

The tiger is the largest species of wild cat in the world.

Тигр — самый крупный вид дикой кошки в мире.

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**trap** /træp/ **A2**

**ловушка**

A device used to catch animals.

The hunters set traps in the forest.

Охотники расставили ловушки в лесу.

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**turtle** /'tɜːtl/ **B1**

**черепаха**

a reptile that lives mainly in water and has a hard shell on its back

Sea turtles travel thousands of miles to lay their eggs on the same beach every year.

Морские черепахи проплывают тысячи миль, чтобы каждый год откладывать яйца на одном и том же пляже.

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**vet** /vet/ (B1)

**ветеринар**

A person trained and qualified to treat sick or injured animals

We took our cat to the vet when she stopped eating and seemed unwell.

Мы отвезли кошку к ветеринару, когда она перестала есть и выглядела нездоровой.

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**whale** weɪl (B1)

**кит**

a very large sea mammal that breathes air

Whales communicate using complex songs.

Киты общаются с помощью сложных песен.

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**whip** wɪp (B2)

**хлыст**

a long thin strip of leather or rope used for hitting animals or people

The rider cracked the whip to make the horse move faster.

Наездник щёлкнул хлыстом, чтобы лошадь побежала быстрее.

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**wildlife** /ˈwaɪldlaɪf/ (B1)

**дикая природа**

animals, birds, and plants that live in natural conditions and are not kept by people

The national park protects local wildlife from hunting.

Национальный парк защищает местную дикую природу от охоты.

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**wing** /wɪŋ/ (B1)

**крыло**

one of the two parts of a bird or insect that it uses to fly

The bird spread its wings and flew away.

Птица расправила крылья и улетела.

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**wolf** /wʊlf/ (B2)

**волк**

a large wild animal of the dog family that lives and hunts in groups

Wolves hunt in packs and can travel great distances.

Волки охотятся стаями и могут преодолевать большие расстояния.

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**worm** /wɜːm/ (B2)

**червь**

A small, thin animal with a soft body and no legs that lives in soil.

After the rain, children found earthworms on the pavement.

После дождя дети обнаружили дождевых червей на тротуаре.

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**zebra** 'zebrə 

**зебра**

An African wild animal like a horse with black and white stripes

We saw a herd of zebras drinking at the waterhole.

Мы увидели стадо зебр, пьющих воду у водопоя.

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**ZOO** zuː 

**зоопарк**

A place where wild animals are kept and shown to the public

We took the children to the zoo to see the lions and elephants.

Мы повели детей в зоопарк посмотреть на львов и слонов.
