actress /'æktɹəs/ **B1**

актриса

a woman whose job is to perform in films, plays, or on television

She became a famous actress after starring in several blockbuster films.

Она стала знаменитой актрисой после того, как снялась в нескольких блокбастерах.

animation /,æni'meɪʃən/ **B1**

анимация

a film or television programme made by taking a series of drawings or computer images that appear to move

The studio is known for producing award-winning animation for children.

Студия известна созданием отмеченной наградами анимации для детей.

applause /ə'plɔːz/ **B1**

аплодисменты

The sound of people clapping their hands together to show they enjoyed or approve of something

The audience burst into applause at the end of the performance.

В конце выступления зрители разразились аплодисментами.

artist /'ɑːtɪst/ **B1**

художник

a person who creates art, such as paintings, drawings, or music

She is a talented artist who paints landscapes.

Она талантливая художница, которая пишет пейзажи.

bust bʌst **B1**

бюст

A sculpture of a person's head, shoulders, and chest; a person's chest, especially a woman's breasts

There is a marble bust of the founder in the entrance hall of the museum.

В вестибюле музея стоит мраморный бюст основателя.

choir /'kwaɪə/ **B1**

хор

A group of people who sing together, especially in a church or school

She sings in the school choir every Thursday evening.

Она поёт в школьном хоре каждый четверг вечером.

chorus ^{ˈkɔːrəs} B1

хор

a group of singers who perform together

She sings in the school chorus.

Она поёт в школьном хоре.

circus ^{ˈsɜː.kəs/} B1

цирк

A travelling show that performs in a large tent, with clowns, acrobats, and sometimes trained animals

The children were excited to see their first circus and especially loved the acrobats.

Дети с нетерпением ждали своего первого цирка и особенно восхищались акробатами.

comedian ^{/kəˈmiːdiən/} B1

комик

a performer whose job is to make people laugh by telling jokes or acting in funny ways

The comedian had the audience laughing throughout the entire show.

Комик заставлял зрителей смеяться на протяжении всего шоу.

comedy ^{ˈkɒmədi/} B1

комедия

a film, play, or TV programme that is funny and makes people laugh

We watched a romantic comedy on TV last night.

Вчера вечером мы посмотрели романтическую комедию по телевизору.

craft ^{kraːft} B1

ремесло

a skill, especially one involving making things by hand; a boat or aircraft

She has mastered the craft of pottery and sells her work online.

Она овладела гончарным мастерством и продаёт свои работы в интернете.

creator ^{/kriˈeɪtə/} B1

создатель

A person who makes or invents something new, or who produces creative work

The creator of the popular cartoon was only twenty-two when she first drew the characters.

Создательнице популярного мультфильма было только двадцать два года, когда она впервые нарисовала персонажей.

debut ^{ˈdeɪbjʊː} B1

дебют

the first public performance or appearance of someone or something

She made her debut as a singer at the age of 16.

Она дебютировала как певица в возрасте 16 лет.

duo /'dju:.əʊ/ **B1**

дуэт

two people who perform together, especially musicians or singers

The piano duo played a beautiful piece.

Фортепианный дуэт исполнил прекрасное произведение.

entertainer /,entə'teɪnə/ **B1**

артист

a person who performs for others to entertain them, such as a singer, comedian, or dancer

He was a brilliant entertainer who could sing, dance, and tell jokes.

Он был блестящим артистом, который умел петь, танцевать и рассказывать анекдоты.

fantasy /'fæntəsi/ **B1**

фантазия

Something that you imagine happening, but that is unlikely to happen in real life; also a genre of fiction with magic and supernatural elements

He lives in a fantasy world where everything is perfect.

Он живёт в мире фантазий, где всё идеально.

filmmaker /'fɪlm,meɪkə/ **B1**

кинорежиссёр

A person who makes films, especially as a director or producer.

The filmmaker won an award for her latest movie.

Кинорежиссёр получила награду за свой последний фильм.

flute /flu:t/ **B1**

флейта

a musical instrument in the shape of a thin tube, played by blowing air across a hole at one end

She has been playing the flute in the school orchestra for three years.

Три года она играет на флейте в школьном оркестре.

guitarist /gɪ'tɑ:rɪst/ **B1**

гитарист

a person who plays the guitar

The lead guitarist played a brilliant solo at the end of the song.

Ведущий гитарист сыграл блестящее соло в конце песни.

illustrator /'ɪləstreɪtə/ **B1**

иллюстратор

a person who draws or paints pictures for books, magazines, etc.

The illustrator created beautiful drawings for the children's book.

Иллюстратор создал прекрасные рисунки для детской книги.

ink ɪŋk **B1**

чернила

A coloured liquid used for writing, drawing, or printing.

The printer has run out of ink, so I need to buy a new cartridge.

В принтере закончились чернила, поэтому мне нужно купить новый картридж.

inscription /ɪn'skɪpʃn/ **B1**

надпись

Words written or carved on a surface, for example on a stone, ring, or book

The inscription on the ancient stone described the life of a king who ruled two thousand years ago.

Надпись на древнем камне описывала жизнь царя, правившего две тысячи лет назад.

intermission /,ɪntə'mɪʃən/ **B1**

антракт

a short break between the parts of a play, concert, or film

We bought popcorn and drinks during the intermission.

Мы купили попкорн и напитки во время антракта.

jazz /dʒæz/ **B1**

джаз

A style of music that developed among African Americans, with strong rhythms and improvisation

She loves listening to jazz when she's working late at night.

Она любит слушать джаз, когда работает поздно ночью.

likeness /'laɪknəs/ **B1**

сходство

the fact of looking or being similar to someone or something; a portrait or image of someone

There is a strong family likeness between the two sisters.

Между двумя сёстрами есть очень сильное семейное сходство.

magician mə'dʒɪʃən **B1**

фокусник

a person who performs magic tricks to entertain people, or a person in stories who can do real magic

The magician pulled a rabbit out of his hat and amazed the children.

Фокусник достал кролика из шляпы и поразил детей.

monument /'mɒnjumənt/ **B1**

памятник

a structure built to remind people of a famous person or event

The city has many monuments dedicated to famous historical figures.

В городе много памятников, посвящённых известным историческим деятелям.

novelist /'nɒv.əl.ɪst/ **B1**

романист

A person who writes novels (long fiction books)

She is a celebrated novelist whose books have been translated into thirty languages.

Она известная романистка, чьи книги переведены на тридцать языков.

orchestra /'ɔːkɪstrə/ **B1**

оркестр

a large group of musicians who play different instruments together

The symphony orchestra gave an outstanding performance last evening.

Вчера вечером симфонический оркестр дал превосходное выступление.

pattern /'pætn/ **B1**

узор

a repeated arrangement of shapes, colours, or lines

The carpet has a beautiful geometric pattern.

Ковёр украшен красивым геометрическим узором.

performer /pə'fɔːmə/ **B1**

исполнитель

a person who entertains an audience by acting, singing, dancing, or playing music

The street performer attracted a large crowd with his juggling act.

Уличный артист привлёк большую толпу своим жонглированием.

poet /'pəʊɪt/ **B1**

поэт

a person who writes poems

Shakespeare is considered one of the greatest poets in the English language.

Шекспир считается одним из величайших поэтов английского языка.

pottery /'pɒtəri/ **B1**

керамика

Objects made from clay that are baked hard, such as plates, bowls, and vases; the activity of making such objects

She takes pottery classes every Wednesday evening.

Каждую среду вечером она ходит на занятия по гончарному делу.

preview /'priː.vjuː/ **B1**

предварительный просмотр

an opportunity to see something (like a movie, show, or product) before it is available to the public

We got a preview of the new movie before it came out.

Мы получили предварительный просмотр нового фильма до его выхода.

rockstar 'rɒksta: **B1**

рок-звезда

a famous musician who plays rock music

The rockstar performed in front of thousands of fans.

Рок-звезда выступила перед тысячами фанатов.

sci-fi 'saɪ.fai **B1**

научная фантастика

a type of story, book, or movie about imaginary future events and advanced technology, often involving space travel or aliens

I love reading sci-fi novels about space exploration.

Я люблю читать научно-фантастические романы об освоении космоса.

sculpture /'skʌlptʃə/ **B1**

скульптура

A work of art that is a solid figure or object made by shaping stone, wood, clay, or metal

The museum has a large collection of ancient sculptures.

В музее большая коллекция древних скульптур.

sequel /'si:kwəl/ **B1**

продолжение

a book, film, or play that continues the story of an earlier one

The sequel to the movie was even more popular than the original.

Сиквел фильма оказался даже популярнее оригинала.

storyteller 'stɔːritɪlə **B1**

рассказчик

A person who tells or writes stories, especially with great skill

Grandma was a wonderful storyteller who could hold everyone's attention.

Бабушка была замечательным рассказчиком и умела удерживать всеобщее внимание.

studio /'stjuːdiəʊ/ **B1**

студия

a room or building used by an artist, photographer, or musician to work in

She painted all her famous works in a large studio by the sea.

Все свои известные работы она написала в большой мастерской у моря.

stunt stʌnt **B1**

трюк

a dangerous or difficult action that is done to entertain people, especially in a film

The actor performed his own stunts in the movie.

Актёр выполнял свои собственные трюки в фильме.

trumpet 'trʌmpɪt B1

труба

A brass wind instrument with a flared bell, played by blowing through a cupped mouthpiece and pressing valves to change pitch

Miles Davis is considered one of the greatest trumpet players in the history of jazz.

Майлз Дэвис считается одним из величайших трубачей в истории джаза.

weaving 'wi:vɪŋ B1

ткачество

the activity of making cloth or other objects by crossing threads or strips over and under each other

She learned traditional weaving from her grandmother.

Она научилась традиционному ткачеству у своей бабушки.
