admiringly /əd'maɪərɪŋli/ B2

с восхищением

in a way that shows you think someone or something is very good or impressive

She looked at the painting admiringly for a long time.

Она долго смотрела на картину с восхищением.

affectionately /ə'fek.ʃən.ɪt.li/ B2

нежно

in a way that shows fondness and tenderness

He patted the dog affectionately on the head.

Он нежно похлопал собаку по голове.

aggressively /ə'gresɪvli/ B2

агрессивно

in a forceful or threatening way; in a very determined and forceful way

He spoke aggressively and made everyone uncomfortable.

Он говорил агрессивно и всех смущал.

amazingly ə'meɪzɪŋli B2

удивительно

in a way that is very surprising and impressive; used to say that something is very unexpected

Amazingly, the old bridge had survived hundreds of years of floods without any damage.

Удивительно, но старый мост пережил сотни лет наводнений без какого-либо ущерба.

bitterly /'bɪt.ə.li/ B2

горько

In a very strong and unhappy way; extremely or very unpleasantly

She wept bitterly when she heard the news of her friend's death.

Она горько заплакала, когда узнала о смерти своей подруги.

blindly /'blaɪndli/ B2

слепо

without thinking carefully or being able to see; without information or reason

You shouldn't blindly follow orders without thinking about the consequences.

Не следует слепо выполнять приказы, не думая о последствиях.

calmly /'kɑ:m.li/ B2

спокойно

In a peaceful, relaxed way, without becoming upset or worried

She calmly explained the problem to the angry customer without raising her voice.

Она спокойно объяснила проблему сердитому клиенту, не повышая голоса.

cheerfully /ˈtʃiəfəli/ B2

весело

in a happy and positive way

She cheerfully agreed to help with the project.

Она радостно согласилась помочь с проектом.

confidently /ˈkɒnfɪdəntli/ B2

уверенно

in a way that shows you believe in your own abilities or are certain that something is true

She walked confidently onto the stage and began her presentation.

Она уверенно вышла на сцену и начала свою презентацию.

crossly /ˈkrɒsli/ B2

сердито

in an angry or irritated way

'I told you not to touch that,' she said crossly.

«Я же сказала тебе не трогать это», — сказала она сердито.

cruelly /ˈkruː.əl.i/ B2

жестоко

in a way that causes pain or suffering; without compassion

He cruelly mocked her in front of everyone.

Он жестоко высмеял её перед всеми.

dearly /ˈdiəli/ B2

очень сильно

very much; at a high cost or price

She loved her children dearly and would do anything for them.

Она очень любила своих детей и готова была сделать для них всё.

deep down /ˌdiːp ˈdaʊn/ B2

в глубине души

in one's true feelings or character, despite what appears outwardly

Deep down, she knew he was lying.

В глубине души она знала, что он лжёт.

desperately /ˈdes.pə.ət.li/ B2

отчаянно

In a way that shows extreme worry or need; with a feeling of hopelessness or urgent desire

She desperately wanted to pass the exam and couldn't sleep the night before.

Она отчаянно хотела сдать экзамен и не могла спать накануне ночью.

eagerly 'i:gəli **B2**

с нетерпением

with great interest and enthusiasm

The children eagerly waited for the presents to be opened.

Дети с нетерпением ждали, когда откроют подарки.

enthusiastically ɪnˌθju:zi'æstɪkli **B2**

с энтузиазмом

in a way that shows great excitement and interest

The crowd cheered enthusiastically when the team scored.

Толпа с энтузиазмом болела за команду, когда та забила гол.

fondly /'fɒnd.li/ **B2**

нежно

in a loving and affectionate way; with tender feelings

She fondly remembered her summers at her grandparents' farm.

Она с нежностью вспоминала лета на ферме своих бабушки и дедушки.

foolishly 'fu:lɪʃli **B2**

глупо

In a way that is not sensible or wise; showing poor judgement

He foolishly agreed to lend money to someone he barely knew.

Он глупо согласился одолжить деньги человеку, которого едва знал.

frantically 'fræntɪkli **B2**

лихорадочно

in a very fast, energetic, and anxious way; in a state of great excitement or worry

She searched frantically through her bag for her phone, but couldn't find it anywhere.

Она лихорадочно рылась в сумке в поисках телефона, но нигде не могла его найти.

furiously 'fjʊəriəsli **B2**

яростно

in a very angry way, or with a lot of energy and speed

She typed furiously, trying to finish the report before the deadline.

Она яростно стучала по клавишам, стараясь закончить отчёт до дедлайна.

generously /'dʒenərəsli/ **B2**

щедро

in a way that gives more than is expected; in a kind and giving way

The donors generously contributed millions of dollars to the charity.

Жертвователи щедро перечислили миллионы долларов на благотворительность.

genuinely 'dʒenjuɪnli (B2)

искренне

in a real and true way; not pretended

She was genuinely happy to see him again.

Она была искренне рада снова его видеть.

impatiently /ɪm'peɪʃəntli/ (B2)

нетерпеливо

in a way that shows you are irritated by having to wait or by something slow

She tapped her foot impatiently while waiting for the bus.

Она нетерпеливо постукивала ногой, ожидая автобус.

irresistibly /ɪr'ɪzɪstɪbli/ (B2)

неотразимо

in a way that is so attractive or strong that you cannot refuse or resist it

The chocolate cake looked irresistibly delicious, so she took a large slice.

Шоколадный торт выглядел неотразимо вкусным, поэтому она взяла большой кусок.

jealously /'dʒeləsli/ (B2)

ревниво

in a way that shows you want what someone else has, or that you want to keep something for yourself

She jealously guarded her recipe and never shared it with anyone.

Она ревниво хранила свой рецепт и никогда ни с кем не делилась им.

negatively 'negətɪvli (B2)

негативно

in a way that shows disapproval or in a harmful or bad way

The news affected the market negatively.

Новость негативно повлияла на рынок.

nervously 'nɜːvəsli (B2)

нервно

in a way that shows anxiety or fear

She nervously bit her lip while waiting for the exam results.

Она нервно кусала губу, ожидая результатов экзамена.

passionately /'pæʃənətli/ (B2)

страстно

in a way that shows very strong feelings or beliefs

She spoke passionately about protecting the environment.

Она страстно говорила о защите окружающей среды.

patiently /ˈpeɪʃntli/ B2

терпеливо

in a calm way, without becoming annoyed or upset while waiting or dealing with difficulties

She waited patiently for her turn in the queue.

Она терпеливо ждала своей очереди.

peacefully /ˈpiːsfəli/ B2

мирно

in a quiet and calm way; without violence or conflict

The children were sleeping peacefully in their beds.

Дети мирно спали в своих кроватках.

proudly ˈpraʊdli B2

гордо

In a way that shows great satisfaction or pleasure in something that you or someone you know has achieved

She proudly displayed the trophy she had won at the national competition.

Она с гордостью выставила кубок, выигранный на национальных соревнованиях.

regrettably /rɪˈɡretəbli/ B2

к сожалению

in a way that is unfortunate and causes you to feel sorry

Regrettably, the concert had to be cancelled due to the storm.

К сожалению, концерт пришлось отменить из-за шторма.

stubbornly /ˈstʌb.ən.li/ B2

упрямо

in a way that refuses to change, despite pressure or argument

She stubbornly refused to admit she was wrong.

Она упрямо отказывалась признать, что была неправа.

tenderly ˈtendəli B2

нежно

in a gentle and loving way, showing care and affection

She tenderly brushed the hair from the sleeping child's face.

Она нежно убрала волосы с лица спящего ребёнка.

unashamedly ʌnəˈʃeɪmɪdli B2

беззастенчиво

in a way that shows no shame or embarrassment about something that others might find wrong

She was unashamedly ambitious and made no secret of it.

Она была беззастенчиво амбициозна и не скрывала этого.

uncomfortably /ʌn'kʌm.fər.tə.bli/ B2

неудобно

in a way that is uncomfortable or causes discomfort

She shifted uncomfortably in her chair during the long meeting.

На долгом совещании она неловко ёрзала на стуле.

uneasily /ʌn'iː.zi.li/ B2

тревожно

in a way that shows anxiety or discomfort; not at ease

She shifted uneasily in her seat during the long silence.

Она беспокойно заёрзала на стуле во время долгой тишины.

unthinkably ʌn'θɪŋkəbli B2

немыслимо

in a way that is so extreme or shocking that it is very hard to believe or accept

The scale of the disaster was unthinkably vast.

Масштаб катастрофы был невысказанно огромным.

willingly /'wɪl.iŋ.li/ B2

охотно

In a way that shows you are happy and ready to do something without being forced

She willingly volunteered to stay late and help finish the project.

Она охотно вызвалась остаться допоздна и помочь завершить проект.
