apple 'æpəl (A1)

яблоко

a round fruit with red, yellow, or green skin and white flesh

She ate an apple every morning for breakfast.

Каждое утро она ела яблоко на завтрак.

apron 'eɪprən (A1)

фартук

a piece of clothing worn over the front of other clothes to keep them clean, especially while cooking

She tied on an apron before starting to cook so she wouldn't get flour on her dress.

Она надела фартук, прежде чем начать готовить, чтобы не испачкать платье мукой.

ate eɪt (A1)

ел

past simple of 'eat' – to put food into your mouth and swallow it

I ate an apple for breakfast.

Я съел яблоко на завтрак.

banana /bə'nɑ:nə/ (A1)

банан

a long curved yellow fruit with soft flesh inside

She peeled a banana and ate it on the way to school.

Она очистила банан и съела его по дороге в школу.

bar /bɑ:/ (A1)

бар

a place where you can buy and drink alcohol and other drinks

We met at a bar after work.

Мы встретились в баре после работы.

bean /bi:n/ (A1)

боб

A seed from various plants, eaten as a vegetable; also the plant itself

She added kidney beans to the chilli.

Она добавила красную фасоль в чили.

beef /bi:f/ (A1)

говядина

the meat of a cow, used as food

I ordered a beef burger with cheese and salad.

Я заказал бургер с говядиной, сыром и салатом.

biscuit 'bɪskɪt (A1)

печенье (брит.)

(British English) a small, flat, dry and usually sweet baked item; (American English) a soft bread roll often eaten with butter

She had a cup of tea and a chocolate biscuit.

Она выпила чашку чая с шоколадным печеньем.

bowl /bəʊl/ (A1)

миска

a round deep dish used for soup, cereal, or mixing food

She filled a bowl with hot soup and brought it to him.

Она наполнила миску горячим супом и принесла ему.

bread /bred/ (A1)

хлеб

a common food made from flour, water, and usually yeast, baked in an oven

She bought a loaf of bread at the bakery.

Она купила буханку хлеба в булочной.

breakfast 'brekfəst (A1)

завтрак

the first meal of the day, eaten in the morning

I usually have cereal and orange juice for breakfast.

На завтрак я обычно ем хлопья и пью апельсиновый сок.

burger 'bɜːgə (A1)

бургер

a flat round piece of minced meat cooked and served in a bread roll

Let's go get a burger for lunch.

Давай возьмём бургер на обед.

butter /'bʌtə/ (A1)

масло

a soft yellow food made from cream, used for spreading on bread or cooking

She spread butter on her toast for breakfast.

Она намазала масло на тост на завтрак.

cafe /'kæfeɪ/ (A1)

кафе

a small restaurant or coffee shop where you can buy drinks and light meals

We met for coffee at a little cafe near the station.

Мы встретились за кофе в небольшом кафе рядом со станцией.

cake /keɪk/ **A1**

торт

a sweet food made by baking a mixture of flour, eggs, butter, and sugar

She baked a beautiful chocolate cake for his birthday.

Она испекла прекрасный шоколадный торт на его день рождения.

candy /'kændi/ **A1**

конфета

Sweet food made from sugar, used especially in American English; a piece of such food.

The children collected candy when they went trick-or-treating on Halloween.

На Хэллоуин дети собирали конфеты, ходя по домам.

cheese tʃiːz **A1**

сыр

a solid or soft food made from milk

She put some cheese and crackers on a plate for the guests.

Она положила на тарелку для гостей немного сыра и крекеров.

chicken /'tʃɪkɪn/ **A1**

курица

a common farm bird raised for its eggs and meat; the meat of this bird

We had roast chicken with vegetables for Sunday dinner.

На воскресный обед у нас была жареная курица с овощами.

chocolate /'tʃɒklət/ **A1**

шоколад

A sweet brown food made from cocoa beans, eaten as a sweet or used in cooking

She gave me a box of chocolates for my birthday.

Она подарила мне коробку шоколадных конфет на день рождения.

coffee /'kɒfi/ **A1**

кофе

a hot brown drink made from roasted ground beans

Would you like a cup of coffee?

Хотите чашку кофе?

coke /kəʊk/ **A1**

кола

a short informal word for Coca-Cola or cola soft drink

Can I have a burger and a coke, please?

Можно мне бургер и колу, пожалуйста?

cook /kʊk/ **A1**

готовить

to prepare food by heating it

I usually cook dinner for the family in the evenings.

Обычно я готовлю ужин для семьи по вечерам.

cookie /ˈkʊki/ **A1**

печенье

a small flat sweet cake that is crisp and dry (American English)

She baked chocolate chip cookies for the school sale.

Она испекла печенье с шоколадной крошкой для школярской ярмарки.

corn /kɔ:n/ **A1**

кукуруза

a tall plant with large yellow seeds that are eaten as food

They grow corn in this region.

В этом регионе выращивают кукурузу.

cream /kri:m/ **A1**

сливки

the thick white fatty liquid that rises to the top of milk, used in cooking or on desserts

Would you like cream in your coffee?

Вы хотите сливки в кофе?

cup /kʌp/ **A1**

чашка

a small round container with a handle, used for drinking hot drinks

Can I have a cup of tea, please?

Можно мне чашку чая, пожалуйста?

delicious /dɪˈlɪʃ.əs/ **A1**

вкусный

having a very pleasant taste or smell

This chocolate cake is absolutely delicious!

Этот шоколадный торт абсолютно восхитителен!

dinner /ˈdɪnə/ **A1**

ужин

the main meal of the day, usually eaten in the evening

What shall we have for dinner?

Что у нас на ужин?

dish /dɪʃ/ **A1**

блюдо

A flat container used for cooking or serving food

She put the salad in a large dish.

Она положила салат в большую миску.

drink /drɪŋk/ **A1**

пить

to take liquid into your mouth and swallow it

Remember to drink plenty of water during the day.

Не забывай пить много воды в течение дня.

eat /i:t/ **A1**

есть

to put food in your mouth, chew it, and swallow it

What did you eat for breakfast?

Что ты ел на завтрак?

egg /eg/ **A1**

яйцо

a round object with a hard shell produced by a female bird or other animal, used as food

I eat two eggs for breakfast every morning.

Я ем два яйца на завтрак каждое утро.

farm /fɑ:m/ **A1**

ферма

an area of land and buildings where people grow crops and raise animals for food

My grandparents lived on a small farm in the countryside.

Мои бабушка и дедушка жили на небольшой ферме в деревне.

feed fi:d **A1**

кормить

To give food to a person or animal

She feeds the birds in her garden every morning.

Каждое утро она кормит птиц в своём саду.

food /fu:d/ **A1**

еда

things that people or animals eat to stay alive and healthy

This restaurant serves excellent Italian food.

В этом ресторане подают отличную итальянскую еду.

fruit /fru:t/ **A1**

фрукт

the sweet, edible part of a plant that contains seeds

Eating plenty of fruit and vegetables is good for your health.

Употребление большого количества фруктов и овощей полезно для здоровья.

grape greɪp **A1**

виноград

a small round fruit, usually purple or green, that grows in clusters and is used to make wine

She picked grapes from the vine in her garden.

Она срывала виноград с лозы в своём саду.

hamburger /'hæm.bɜ:.gər/ **A1**

гамбургер

a flat round patty of minced beef served in a bread bun

He ordered a hamburger and fries at the fast food restaurant.

Он заказал гамбургер и картошку фри в ресторане быстрого питания.

hungry /'hʌŋɡri/ **A1**

голодный

feeling the need to eat because your stomach is empty

I didn't eat breakfast so I'm very hungry by lunchtime.

Я не завтракал, поэтому к обеду очень голоден.

juice /dʒu:s/ **A1**

сок

the liquid that comes from fruit or vegetables when you press them

Would you like a glass of orange juice?

Хочешь стакан апельсинового сока?

knife /naɪf/ **A1**

нож

a tool with a sharp metal blade used for cutting food or as a weapon

Please use a knife and fork to eat your meal.

Пожалуйста, ешьте ножом и вилкой.

lunch lʌntʃ **A1**

обед

a meal eaten in the middle of the day

We always eat lunch together as a family at noon on Sundays.

По воскресеньям мы всегда обедаем вместе как семья в полдень.

meal /mi:l/ **A1**

приём пищи

food that you eat at one sitting, especially breakfast, lunch, or dinner

We had a delicious meal at the restaurant.

В ресторане мы пообедали очень вкусно.

meat /mi:t/ **A1**

мясо

the flesh of an animal used as food

She doesn't eat meat.

Она не ест мясо.

milk /milk/ **A1**

молоко

a white liquid that comes from cows, goats, or other animals and is drunk as a food

I drink a glass of milk every morning.

Каждое утро я выпиваю стакан молока.

orange /'brɪndʒ/ **A1**

апельсин

a round, sweet fruit with a thick skin; also the colour between red and yellow

She had orange juice for breakfast.

На завтрак она выпила апельсиновый сок.

party /'pɑ:ti/ **A1**

вечеринка

a social event where people eat, drink, and enjoy themselves

We're having a birthday party on Saturday.

В субботу у нас день рождения.

picnic /'pɪk.nɪk/ **A1**

пикник

A meal eaten outdoors in a natural setting, taken from home in a basket or bag

We packed sandwiches and fruit and went on a picnic in the park.

Мы упаковали бутерброды и фрукты и отправились на пикник в парк.

pizza /'pi:tʃə/ **A1**

пицца

a flat round bread baked with tomato sauce, cheese, and other toppings on top

Let's order a pizza for dinner tonight.

Давай закажем пиццу на ужин сегодня.

potato /pə'teɪtəʊ/ (A1)

картофель

a round vegetable with a brown or yellow skin that grows underground

We had roast chicken and mashed potatoes for dinner.

На обед у нас была жареная курица и картофельное пюре.

restaurant /'restɒrənt/ (A1)

ресторан

a place where you can buy and eat a meal

We booked a table at an Italian restaurant for Saturday evening.

Мы забронировали столик в итальянском ресторане на субботний вечер.

rice /raɪs/ (A1)

рис

small white or brown seeds that are cooked and eaten as food

She cooked rice and vegetables for dinner.

Она приготовила рис с овощами на ужин.

salad /'sæləd/ (A1)

салат

a cold dish made mainly from vegetables or fruits, sometimes with meat, fish, eggs, or other ingredients mixed together

I ordered a chicken salad for lunch.

Я заказала салат с курицей на обед.

sandwich 'sænwɪdʒ (A1)

бутерброд

two pieces of bread with food between them

I had a cheese sandwich for lunch.

На обед я съел бутерброд с сыром.

soup /su:p/ (A1)

суп

A hot liquid food made by cooking vegetables, meat, or fish in water

She made a big pot of vegetable soup for the whole family.

Она сварила большую кастрюлю овощного супа для всей семьи.

sugar /'ʃʊɡə/ (A1)

сахар

a sweet white or brown substance used to sweeten food and drink, made from plants like sugarcane or sugar beet

How many spoonfuls of sugar do you take in your tea?

Сколько ложек сахара ты кладёшь в чай?

supermarket 'su:pəmə:kɪt (A1)

супермаркет

a large shop that sells food and other goods

She bought everything she needed at the supermarket.

Она купила всё необходимое в супермаркете.

sweet /swi:t/ (A1)

сладкий

having a pleasant sugary taste; kind and pleasant

The strawberries are very sweet this summer.

Клубника в этом году очень сладкая.

tea /ti:/ (A1)

чай

a hot drink made by pouring boiling water onto dried leaves; also the plant whose leaves are used

Would you like a cup of tea?

Хотите чашку чая?

tomato /tə'mɑ:təʊ/ (A1)

помидор

A round red fruit that is eaten as a vegetable in salads and cooking.

She sliced a fresh tomato and put it in the salad.

Она нарезала свежий помидор и добавила его в салат.

turkey /'tɜ:ki/ (A1)

индейка

a large farm bird kept for its meat, especially eaten at Thanksgiving and Christmas

We had roast turkey for Thanksgiving dinner.

На ужин в День благодарения мы ели жареную индейку.

vegetable /'vedʒtəbəl/ (A1)

овощ

a plant or part of a plant used as food

We should eat more vegetables and fruit every day.

Нам следует каждый день есть больше овощей и фруктов.

waiter /'weɪtə/ (A1)

официант

a person who brings food and drink to tables in a restaurant or café

The waiter brought the menu and asked if they were ready to order.

Официант принёс меню и спросил, готовы ли они сделать заказ.

yoghourt 'jɒgət 

йогурт

a thick, slightly sour food made from milk with bacteria added to it

| She eats yoghurt with fruit for breakfast every morning.

| Каждое утро она завтракает йогуртом с фруктами.

yoghurt /'jɒgət/ 

йогурт

A thick, slightly sour food made from milk that has been treated with bacteria, often eaten with fruit or as a snack.

| She had a yoghurt and some fruit for breakfast.

| На завтрак она съела йогурт и немного фруктов.

yogurt 'jɒgət 

йогурт

a thick, slightly sour food made from milk that has been fermented with bacteria

| She has a yogurt and some fruit for breakfast every day.

| Каждый день на завтрак она ест йогурт и немного фруктов.
